Chapter 126.

Resolve in favor of Joseph D. Roberts.

Approved March 25, 1839.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to Joseph D. Roberts, Twenty Five Dollars for his services as Adjutant of the Third Regiment, Second Brigade and First Division of the Militia of the State, from January seventh eighteen hundred and thirty eight, to January seventh, eighteen hundred and thirty nine.
