#### Chapter 14.

AN ACT to extend the time to locate and construct the Portland, Saco and Portsmouth Rail Road.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That there shall be allowed four years to do and perform each Four years in ad-of the several acts and things required to be done time allowed. by the twelfth section of the Act entitled "an Act to establish the Portland, Saco and Portsmouth Rail Road Company," in addition to the several times therein allowed to do and perform the same.
