Chapter 17.

AN ACT additional to an Act entitled "an Act altering the times of holding the District Court for the Western District in the County of Franklin."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the Act to which this is additional, shall take effect and be in force from and after the nineteenth day of February instant, instead of the first day of March as provided in said Act.

When to take effect.

[Approved February 18, 1840.]

Chapter 18.

AN ACT to change the name of Oxford Bridge Corporation.

SEC. 5. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled,* That from and after the passage of this Act, the Corporation heretofore known by the name of Oxford Bridge Corporation, be, and the same hereby is changed to that of Jay Bridge Corporation; and that all records, contracts, and other transactions, relating to, and binding upon said Corporation, and all other parties connected therewith, shall have the same binding effect as if the name of said Corporation had not been changed.

Name changed.

Records, contracts, &c. to remain binding.

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That all Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, be, and the same hereby are repealed.

Provisions of former act repealed.
