Chapter 29.

AN ACT authorizing the proprietors of the old meeting house, so called, in Woolwich to alter, repair and appraise the same.

Persons authorized to make repairs, &c.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled,* That John Stinson, Samuel H. Fullerton and Christopher T. Otis in behalf of the First Parish in Woolwich hereby are authorized to repair and alter the old meeting house in Woolwich so called and assess the cost of the same together with the amount they shall have to pay to pew-holders as is herein after provided, upon the pews in said house.

An appraisal to be made previous to repairing.

Persons objecting to the repairs, entitled to their proportion of the value of the pews, &c., if called for within 6 months.

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That previous to the time of repairing and altering said house the aforesaid John Stinson, Samuel H. Fullerton, and Christopher T. Otis shall cause an appraisal to be made by three disinterested persons who are not proprietors of the relative value of the pews in said house, that any proprietor or proprietors objecting to such repair and alteration being made, shall receive from the aforesaid John Stinson, Samuel H. Fullerton and Christopher T. Otis, his or their proportion of the value of said pews according to the aforesaid appraisal and said Stinson, Fullerton and Otis, shall be held and obliged to pay over to any person or persons his or their proportion of the aforesaid appraisal upon their giving satisfactory evidence that they are entitled to the same. And if any proprietor or proprietors shall fail to call for his or her proportion within six months after such appraisal as aforesaid and notice of the same being posted up in two public places in said town of Woolwich, shall forfeit the same to the persons named in the first section of this Act to be by them appropriated towards repairing and altering said house.
