they hereby are, exempted from military duty, except being called out, detached or drafted to suppress insurrection or repel invasion, so long as they belong to said department, Provided the number attached to said department shall not exceed eight hundred.

Chapter 37.

AN ACT additional to "an Act to annex Wales to the County of Kennebec."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That an Act to annex the town of Wales to the County of Act to which this is additional to take effect from seventh day of January in the year of our Lord one proval. thousand eight hundred and forty, shall take effect, and be in force, from and after the approval of this Act by the Governor.

Chapter 38.

AN ACT accepting the surrender of the charter of the City Bank, Portland.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the charter of the City Bank be, and Acceptance the same hereby is accepted, and the same shall terminate when this act shall take effect.

Sec. 2. Be it further enacted, That the said Corporate powers to continue two Bank shall continue in its corporate capacity for and years.
