they hereby are, exempted from military duty, except being called out, detached or drafted to suppress insurrection or repel invasion, so long as they belong to said department, *Provided* the number attached to said department shall not exceed eight hundred.

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**Chapter 37.**

AN ACT additional to "an Act to annex Wales to the County of Kennebec."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled,* That an Act to annex the town of Wales to the County of Kennebec, approved by the Governor the twenty-seventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty, shall take effect, and be in force, from and after the approval of this Act by the Governor.

Act to which this is additional to take effect from the date of its approval.

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**Chapter 38.**

AN ACT accepting the surrender of the charter of the City Bank, Portland.

**SEC. 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled,* That the charter of the City Bank be, and the same hereby is accepted, and the same shall terminate when this act shall take effect.

Acceptance of charter.

**SEC. 2.** *Be it further enacted,* That the said Bank shall continue in its corporate capacity for and
