Sec. 2. Be it further enacted, That the Expenses to be borne equally by expenses of said Commission shall be borne equally each of said towns-liow reby said towns of Bath and Phipsburg. And covered. the said Commissioners may have and maintain their several actions against either of said towns for their services and expenses in establishing said line, according to the provisions of this Act: and the town which shall pay the same, may have and maintain an action against the other, for its proportional share of the sum so paid. And this Act shall be in force from and after the first day of April next.

#### Chapter 43.

AN ACT additional to "an Act to incorporate the Trustees of Parsonsfield Seminary."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the Trustees of Parsonsfield Seminary are hereby Number of Trustees authorized to increase their number to twenty-one creased to 20. instead of the number specified in their Act of incorporation.
