Chapter 54.

AN ACT authorizing the County Commissioners for the County of Waldo to lay out a road over tide waters of Goose River Creek in the town of Camden.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the County Commissioners for the County of Waldo, be, and they hereby are authorized and empowered to lay out a road over the tide waters of Goose River Creek in the town of Camden.

County Commissioners may lay out a road over Goose river creek in Camden.

Chapter 55.

AN ACT to limit the compensation of Sheriff in the County of Franklin.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the compensation of Sheriff in and for the County of Franklin be and hereby is limited to the sum of three hundred dollars per annum.*

Compensation, \$300.

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted, That the Sheriff of said County be, and he hereby is required to pay over to the Treasurer of said County annually after deducting the aforesaid sum of three hundred dollars all such surplus as the several Sheriffs in this State are by law required to pay over to the Treasurers of their respective Counties.*

Surplus over 300 dollars to be paid County of Franklin.
