Chapter 65.

AN ACT additional to an Act to incorporate the Bangor and Piscataquis Canal and Rail Road Company.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled,* That the proprietors of the Bangor and Piscataquis Canal and Rail Road Company have power to extend their Rail Road from the point where it now terminates at Old Town village, to the mills on Old Town falls and thence across Penobscot river to or near the mills in Milford.

Authorized to extend the limits of their road.

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That said Company shall have power to enter upon, take, use and occupy any lands or other real estate which they may find necessary for the construction of said road, in the same manner as prescribed in section fourth of their original charter being subject to its provisions and penalties, *Provided however* that this Act shall be void if said extension of road is not completed within six years from the passage of this Act: and that no existing bridge or mills shall be taken or affected by said corporation, without the consent of the owner or owners thereof: nor shall any other bridge be erected by said corporation across the Penobscot river, than such a one as may be necessary to sustain the rails or tracts of said road and be for the sole use and accommodation of the same.

May occupy any land or other estate for the construction of said road.

No mills or bridge to be taken or affected without consent of the owner.
