Chapter 68.

AN ADDITIONAL ACT to incorporate the Magurawock and Schoodaic Canal Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That a further time of three years, from and after the passing of this Act, shall be allowed to the corporation of the Magurawock and Schoodaic Canal Company to make and complete, by an Act of the Legislature of this State, passed the fifteenth day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four, without forfeiting their charter or losing any powers, privileges or immunities granted said corporation by said Act.

[Approved March 16, 1840.]

Three years in addition to the former act allowed to complete the Canal.

Chapter 69.

AN ACT to divide the Ministerial Fund in Turner.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the Trustees of the Ministerial and School Fund in the town of Turner, be and they hereby are directed and empowered to divide annually the interest arising on said Ministerial Fund among the several protestant settled ministers in said Turner, in proportion to the ratable polls adhering or belonging to the societies or parishes of said ministers respectively; Provided the minister and a majority of the first parish agree thereto.*

Interest of fund to be divided annually among the several parishes.

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted, That the legal voters in said town are hereby empowered and authorized to proceed in such manner as they may deem proper to enumerate the adherents to the said several societies in said town and to ascertain the number belonging to each, that an equitable division may be had.*

Enumeration of adherents to each society to be ascertained by the legal voters of the town.

[Approved March 16, 1840.]
