#### Chapter 80.

AN ACT additional to "an Act relating to the Passamaquoddy Tribe

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the Agent of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians is hereby authorized and directed to disannully to the distressed poor. tribute to the distressed poor of that tribe the sum of three hundred dollars in money, annually, in sums not to exceed twenty-five dellars per month, in such portions to each of such distressed persons as his or her circumstances may seem to demand said money to be distributed by the agent in person.

Sec. 2. Be it further enacted, That the fourth section of an Act entitled an Act additional Part of former to an Act relating to the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians, approved March 13, 1839, be and the same is hereby repealed.

### Chapter 81.

AN ACT altering the time of holding the District Court in the County of Piscataquis.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the District Court for the Eastern 15

#### Chapter 82.

AN ACT authorizing school district No. 3 in Thomaston to sell their School house and land.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled. That the third School district in Thomaston be authorized to sell and convey their school house in said town together with the lot of land on which the same Agent authorized stands by their Agent to make execute and delivto dispose of house and lot, &c. er a good and sufficient deed thereof to the purchaser or purchasers, provided said district at a legal meeting of the inhabitants thereof shall vote in favor of such sale, and the proceeds of such sale, shall be disposed of according to vote of said district.
