Chapter 86.

AN ACT authorizing the several School Districts in the town of Winthrop, to purchase the School Library.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled,* That the several School Districts in the town of Winthrop in the County of Kennebec, are hereby authorized to purchase with the money that they receive from the State for school purposes, the "School Library;" *provided* a majority of the district shall so vote, *and provided* they do not expend more than fifty per cent. of the money so received.

The several districts authorized to expend 50 per cent. of money received from the State, in the purchase of a library.

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That if any two districts choose to unite for the purchase of said Library, they are hereby authorized so to do.

Any two districts may unite, &c.

SEC. 3. *Be it further enacted,* That every district that purchases the Library aforesaid, shall make such rules and regulations for the preservation and management of said Library as they may deem proper.

May make rules and regulations.

Chapter 87.

AN ACT additional to an Act to provide for repair of highways in certain unincorporated townships.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled,* That from and after the passing of this Act the provisions of the first section of the Act entitled "an Act to provide for the repair of highways in certain unincorporated townships" approved April first, eighteen hundred and thirty-six, be and hereby is extended to the roads laid out and made by the State of Maine or by said State and the Common-

Provisions of former act extended to other roads therein named.
