Chapter 3.

Resolve for authenticating the Probate Records of the County of Cumberland.

Preamble.

Whereas a part of the Records in the Probate office for the County of Cumberland, during the last sickness of the late John L. Megquier, late Register of Probate for said County, were not duly authenticated by the signing of his name thereto,

Register to certify records not heretofore certified.

Resolved, That the Register of Probate who shall be appointed by the Governor and Council, for said County of Cumberland, as the successor to the said John L. Megquier deceased, shall be, and hereby is, authorized to examine and certify all such Probate records, for said County, as were not duly certified by the said Megquier, previous to his decease, and, when so certified, they shall have the same force and validity as if they had been duly authenticated by the said Megquier while living and in office.

Chapter 4.

Resolve in favor of Henry L. Noyes.

Henry L. Noyes, pension, §48.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to Henry L. Noyes of Waterford, the sum of four dollars per month for one year for an injury sustained by him, while doing military duty.
