### Chapter 10.

#### Resolve directing the mode of authenticating securities issued by the State.

*Resolved*, That all State securities or certificates of stock, hereafter issued on the faith and credit of All State securithe State, shall be signed by the Treasurer, as such, ties to be signed by the Governor, attested and num- countersigned by the Governor, attested and numbered by the Secretary of State, and a record of and numbered and the number of every such security or certificate of recorded by the Secretary of State. stock, together with the date and amount thereof. the rate of interest thereon, shall be made and kept by the Secretary of State. Provided, however, certificates of interest on any such securities or certificates shall be signed by the Treasurer only.

### Chapter 11.

### Resolve in relation to Military Pensions.

Resolved, That the Committee on Military Pensions, be and they hereby are instructed to adopt Evidence for mil-itary pensions to the same rules and regulations, and to require the be the same as same evidence, so far as practicable, in all applica- of Congress. tions for pecuniary relief in consequence of injuries received in the actual service of the State for the protection of the northeastern frontier, as are prescribed by an Act of Congress entitled "an Act to provide for persons who were disabled by known wounds received in the revolutionary war," passed April 10th, 1806.
