## Chapter 12.

Resolve in favor of William Thompson.

William Thompson, for expenses of sickness, \$60.

*Resolved*, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to William Thompson the sum of sixty dollars, it being in full for the expenses of his sickness while a member of the Legislature in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine.

## Chapter 13.

Resolve in favor of Betsey Kimball.

On the petition of Betsey Kimball, widow of Barnard Kimball, late of Vienna in the County of Kennebec, deceased.

Rights of the State transferred to Betsey Kimball.

*Resolved*, That all the right, title, or interest in the real estate, of which the said Barnard Kimball died seized and possessed, or to which he had any legal claim at the time of his decease, so far as the same is liable to escheat to this State for want of heirs of the deceased be, and the same hereby is, transferred and assigned to the said Betsey Kimball, her heirs and assigns forever; *Provided* that this Resolve shall not be construed so as to impair the rights of creditors, or other persons interested in the said estate.
