Chapter 18.

Resolve respecting the Geological Survey of the State.

Resolved, That as soon as the finances of the State will allow, the Geological Survey should be resumed and completed. Geological Survey to be resumed.

[*Approved February 24, 1840.*]

Chapter 19.

Resolve for payment of Bounty to the Penobscot Indians upon Agricultural productions.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid from the Treasury of this State to Henry Richardson, Agent for the Penobscot Tribe of Indians, the sum of two hundred and seventy-three dollars and fifty-two cents, being the amount paid by said Agent to the Indians aforesaid, for bounties upon agricultural productions. \$273 52 for agricultural productions.

Chapter 20.

Resolve directing the manner of binding the pamphlet Laws and Resolves.

Resolved, That the Laws and Resolves required to be published by Resolve of June 28, 1820, be hereafter bound together in the same volume, with suitable title pages and analytical indices. Laws and Resolves to be bound in one volume.
