Resolved, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to Benjamin P. Chapman the sum B. P. Chapman, of forty dollars, it being in full for expenses, incurred pension, \$40, by sickness, while in the Aroostook expedition.

### Chapter 30.

Resolve in favor of Ephraim B. McCondra of Houlton.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to Ephraim B. McCondra of E. B. McConda, Houlton five dollars per month for two years, it pension, \$60 per being for an injury sustained, while in the military service of the State in the Aroostook expedition.
