**Chapter 57.**

Resolve in favor of Elisha Hilton.

*Resolved,* That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of the State, to Elisha Hilton, who lives on the Canada road, the sum of ten dollars in lieu of his share of school fund, and the Governor with advice of the Council, is hereby authorized to draw his warrant for the same—when the said Hilton shall furnish satisfactory proof that he has expended that sum, in instructing his children.

\$10 allowed in lieu of School Fund.

[*Approved March 16, 1840.*]

**Chapter 58.**

Resolve in favor of the school on George's Island.

*Resolved,* That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of the State to Ebenezer Otis of Saint George, the sum of thirty-three dollars, for the use of the common school on George's Island, and the Governor, with the advice of the Council, is hereby authorized to draw his warrant for the same.

\$33 allowed for school on George's Island.

**Chapter 58.**

Resolve in favor of Albert Hanson.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the Treasury of this State to Albert Hanson of Belfast, the sum of seven dollars per month for two years commencing on the twenty-third day of April one thou-

Albert Hanson—military pension, \$84 per annum for two years.
