Chapter 64.

Resolve in favor of John Morrill.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State, to John Morrill of Cornville, the sum of thirty dollars in addition to his pay as member of the House of Representatives, to defray the expenses incurred by sickness during this session of the Legislature.

John Morrill, 30 dollars for expenses of sickness.

Chapter 65.

Resolve in favor of Ebenezer Jones.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to Ebenezer Jones, Treasurer of the town of Lebanon, six dollars and seventeen cents for an error, in allowing and paying bounty on Wheat and Corn, for the year 1838.

Treasurer of Lebanon, 6 dollars 17 cts., for wheat and corn bounty.

Chapter 66.

Resolve for the preservation and repair of the Canada Road.

Resolved, That a sum not exceeding one thousand dollars be and hereby is appropriated for repairing the State Road from the north line of the Kennebec Bingham Purchase to the north line of the State, and that the Governor with the advice of the Council, is hereby authorized to appoint an Agent to superintend the affairs of said road, at a compensation not exceeding two dollars per day.

1000 dollars for repair of road.
