Resolved, That the Governor be requested to forward a certified copy of these Resolutions to each of our Senators and Representatives in Congress.

Chapter 78.

Resolve authorizing the payment of interest on the temporary loan, approved February 15, 1839.

Resolved, That the Treasurer of State be and he hereby is authorized and directed to pay the interest of the temporary loan, authorized to be made by Resolve, approved February fifteenth, 1839, annually, until the repayment of the principal.

Treasurer directed to pay interest on the temporary loan.

Chapter 79.

Resolve making appropriations of land for officers and soldiers of the Revolution, and their widows.

Resolved, That township numbered eight in the third range of townships west from the east line of State, in the County of Aroostook, is hereby appropriated in lieu of township letter D. in the first range, to satisfy the holders of certificates for land, issued by the Land Agent, under Resolves approved March 17, 1835, March 20, 1838.—And Resolve additional, approved March 23, 1838, and under special Resolves referring thereto where the holders of certificates have not selected lots and received deeds, nor have had lots assigned for that purpose, and for satisfying claimants whose claims may hereafter be allowed by virtue of said Resolves, or for any subsequent special or general Resolve that may
