and to issue new Stock, one fourth to be dated March the 1st, one fourth, September 1st, one fourth, November first, 1840, and the other fourth January 1st 1841, and to make the same, with the interest thereon, payable at the Treasury. The terms of the certificates to be the same as to interest, as the certificates cancelled.

Chapter 103.

Resolve in relation to the bequest of Bryce McLellen.

Resolved, That the Treasurer of the State be authorized to receive the bequest of the late Bryce McLellen, Esq. and to invest the same in such manner as in his opinion will best effect the object of the donor.

Amount of the bequest to be invested.

Chapter 104.

Resolve in favor of Elisha Hopkins.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid to Elisha Hopkins of Carmel, out of the Treasury from any money not otherwise appropriated, the sum of eighty-six dollars, being for his pay as member of the House of Representatives, for travel and attendance at the extra session of the Legislature, not having been made up on the pay roll.

Pay of travel and attendance as Representative, \$86.
