Chapter 132.

AN ACT to authorize the owners of the First Congregational Meetinghouse in Vassalborough to dispose of the same.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That Samuel Redington, John G. Hall and Thomas Carlton, with other owners of the first Congregational meeting-house in Vassalborough be, and they hereby are authorized and empowered to sell and convey or Manner of sale. dispose of said house, in such manner as they shall lawfully determine; the proceeds of the sale thereof Proceeds, how to be deposited in the hands of a committee composed disposed of. of three discreet and judicious men, to be disposed of as the owners of said house may direct: Provided, that if any person or persons have a right in the Rights of others, above named house, separate from the owners above how protected. named, the committee, who may be appointed to receive the proceeds of the sale of said house, shall Pews to be ap-appraise the relative value of the pews in said house, previous to the sale of the same, and shall cause to be paid to such person or persons their just proportion of the amount of the appraisal, after deducting all necessary expenses, if called for within one year after the sale of said house.

SECT. 2. Be it further enacted, That this Act when to take shall take effect and be in force from and after its apeffect. proval by the Governor.
