#### Chapter 177.

AN ACT to annex part of the town of Fairfield to the town of Norridgewock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That from and after the passing of this Act, so much of the town of Description. Fairfield, as is contained in lot numbered nine, on the great lot E two, with the inhabitants thereon, be and -from Fairfield the same hereby is set off from the town of Fairfield, -to Norridge-wock. and annexed to the town of Norridgewock, in the County of Somerset.

#### Chapter 178.

AN ACT to repeal an Act entitled an act for the relief of School Districts in Norridgewock and Mercer.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-Act of Feb. 7, sentatives in Legislature assembled, That "an Act 1926, repealed. entitled an Act for the entitled an Act for the relief of school districts in Norridgewock and Mercer," approved February seventh, eighteen hundred and twenty-six, be and the same hereby is repealed.

## Chapter 179.

AN ACT to incorporate the Augusta Free Ferry.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That Loring Cushing, Joseph W. Patterson, John A. Pettingill, Benjamin Pettingill, Elijah Ingraham, Elijah McFarland, Elisha Barrows, Junior, Lebbeus Hayward and John K. Killsa, their associates and successors, be, and hereby are incorporated a body politic and corpo-Corporate name rate, by the name of the Augusta Free Ferry, for the purpose of establishing and running a free ferry across the Kennebec river, in Augusta, and in the same place
