**Chapter 115.**

RESOLVE in favor of George Sawtell.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the treasury of this State, to George Sawtell of Sidney, two dollars per month for two years, in consequence of an injury received by him while doing military duty.

**Chapter 116.**

RESOLVE in favor of Richard F. Perkins.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the State treasury, the sum of five hundred and sixty-six dollars and thirty-five cents, to Richard F. Perkins of Augusta, for loss sustained by him in a contract to furnish lumber for the Insane Hospital made by Charles Keen, agent for the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, to make contracts for materials, and to superintend the erection of said Hospital and other buildings connected therewith, dated December seventh, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, with James O. Eaton, assigned by said Eaton to said Perkins, and which was not fulfilled by Henry Winslow, successor to said Keen. And the Governor is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant in favor of said Perkins therefor.

**Chapter 117.**

RESOLVE in favor Ephraim S. Crockett.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the treasury of the State, to Ephraim S. Crockett of Norway, three dollars per month, for three years from the twenty-eighth day of March one thousand eight hundred thirty-nine, in consideration of an injury received by him while in the service of the State.
