Chapter 151.

RESOLVE in favor of Samuel C. Stevens.

S. C. Stevens,
\$35, for transportation of stores, in Aroostook expedition.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid, out of the treasury of the State, to Samuel C. Stevens, the sum of thirty-five dollars, in full for his services, in transporting subsistence from Bangor to Houlton, for the use of the troops under the command of Major General Hodsdon, in the year eighteen hundred and thirty-nine.
