**Chapter 153.**

RESOLVE laying a tax on the several Counties in the State.

*Resolved,* That the sums annexed to the several Counties contained in the following schedule be, and the same are hereby granted as a tax for each County respectively, to be apportioned, assessed, collected and applied, for the purpose of paying the debt and necessary expenses of the same and other purposes ordered by law.

- York, Five thousand five hundred dollars,
- Cumberland, Seventeen thousand dollars,
- Lincoln, Eight thousand dollars,
- Hancock, Five thousand five hundred dollars,
- Washington, Five thousand dollars,
- Kennebec, Twelve thousand six hundred and forty-two dollars,
- Oxford, Five thousand dollars,
- Somerset, Five thousand five hundred dollars,
- Penobscot, Sixteen thousand seven hundred and twenty-five dollars,
- Waldo, Seven thousand five hundred dollars,
- Piscataquis, Thirty-three hundred and thirty-five dollars,
- Franklin, Three thousand one hundred and fifty dollars,
- Aroostook, Two thousand four hundred and twenty-five dollars.

**Chapter 154.**

RESOLVE in favor of Dennis Fairbanks.

*Resolved,* That the Land Agent is hereby authorized to cancel and discharge the bond, given to the Land Agent to cancel bond of Sept. 6, 1839—
