Chapter 194.

RESOLVE on the Pay Roll of the House of Representatives.

Chapter 197.

RESOLUTIONS in relation to the Currency.

Resolved, That the policy of this country, in public and private financial matters, has always been to maintain a mixed money of paper and metals, the latter forming the basis of the former; that bank paper
