Chapter 54.

AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

That in order to provide for the operation of certain acts and resolves of the legislature requiring the payment of money from the treasury ; and also to provide for the necessary expenditures of the government, for the current year, the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated, to be paid out of any moneys in the treasury. And the governor, with the advice of council, is hereby authorized, at any time prior to the first day of January next, to draw his warrants on the treasurer of State for the same.

Expenditures of government.

Chapter 55.

AN ACT to apportion and assess on the inhabitants of this State a tax of two hundred one thousand six hundred and three dollars sixty seven cents.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. That each city, town, plantation, or other place hereinafter named, within this State, shall be assessed and pay the several sums with which they respectively stand charged, viz:
