Chapter 59.CHAP. 59.

AN ACT relating to certain town officers of the town of Lincolville.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

In any action, hereafter commenced, wherein it may be necessary to prove that any town officer of the town of Lincolville, for the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty four, one thousand eight hundred and thirty five, or one thousand eight hundred and thirty six, was duly sworn to the faithful discharge of the duties of his office, it shall be lawful to prove the administration of such oath by parol testimony.
