POLAND.-DURHAM.

Chapter 62.

Resolve to correct an error in the number of polls in the town of Poland, and for correcting the state and connty tax on said town.

Valuation of the town of Poland corrected, Resolved, That so much of a resolve, passed on the thirteenth day of April in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty one, as relates to the number of polls of the town of Poland, in the county of Cumberland, and to the aggregate number of polls of said county, be repealed, and that the number of polls of said town be three hundred and thirty eight, and that the aggregate number of polls of said county be eleven thousand eight hundred and sixty six; and that the treasurer of the state and the treasurer of the county of Cumberland, be hereby directed to abate or refund, as the case may require, to the said town of Poland, such portion of the state and county tax respectively, which may have been assessed, as the above correction in the number of polls of said town of Poland may require.

Chapter 63.

Resolve to correct a clerical error in the valuation of the town of Durham, and for correcting the state and county tax on said town.

Valuation of the town of Durham corrected. Resolved, That so much of a resolve, passed on the thirteenth day of April, in the year of our Lord, eighteen hundred and forty one, as relates to the valuation of the town of Durham, in the county of Cumberland, and to the aggregate valuation of said county, be repealed, and that the valuation of said town, be two hundred eighty nine thousand, six hundred and fourteen dollars; and that the aggregate valuation of said county be, eleven millions, five hundred, two thousand and forty dollars; and that the treasurer of the state and the treasurer of the county of Cumberland are hereby directed to abate or refund, as the case may require, to the said town of Durham, such portion of the state and county tax respectively, which may have been assessed, as the above correction in the valuation of said town of Durham may require.
