RESOLVES

PASSED BY THE

LEGISLATURE OF MAINE, AT THE EXTRA SESSION,

1842.

Chapter 110.

Resolve in relation to the state valuation.

Resolved, That the number of polls set to the valuation of the town of Clinton in the county of Kennebec be two hundred and seventy, and the amount of estate set against said town be one hundred, sixty two thousand, one hundred and eighty three dollars, instead of the number and sum fixed by the valuation resolve of eighteen hundred and forty one. And the valuation of the town of Sebec in said county, be one hundred and eighty eight polls, and one hundred, thirteen thousand, six hundred and forty one dollars, as estate; and all state and county taxes shall be assessed accordingly, commencing with the present year. And this resolve shall take effect at its approval.
