Extra Session, 1842.

Chapter 119.

Resolve in favor of George W. Cummings.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of the state to George W. Cummings the sum of eight dollars and ninety six cents, for services in investigating an election in the second company of infantry, in the first regiment, second brigade and ninth division.
