Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of this state, to the several persons named in the pay roll of the house of representatives of the extra session, of the twenty second legislature of the state of Maine, the sum set against their respective names, amounting in the whole to seven thousand, seven hundred and six dollars.
