Chapter 70.

AN ACT in relation to the tax assessed on the members of the Brunswick village corporation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The treasurer of the town of Brunswick, is hereby Treasurer of authorized to sue for and collect, all or any moneys in the hands of collect moneys Richard Holland or his bondsmen, or in the hands of any other person corporation. or persons, whomsoever, which was raised by a tax assessed on the members of the Brunswick village corporation.

All moneys received or collected by virtue of this act, To what purposes to be applied. shall be applied to the use and purposes for which it was originally assessed and collected; and the selectmen of Brunswick are hereby authorized to appropriate the same.

Chapter 71.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Milford to build a part of a certain road in the town of Greenbush and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

That the inhabitants of the town of Milford be au- Town of Milford authorized, and they are hereby authorized and empowered, to build build a part of such part of the county road, heretofore laid out, running east from voted so to do in town meeting. Penobscot river through the said town of Milford, and through the south part of the town of Greenbush, into and through the town of Greenfield in this state, lying within said town of Greenbush, as two thirds of the legal voters of said town of Milford, shall in a legal town meeting, held for the purpose, vote to build.

The said inhabitants shall, after having voted as Power to raise aforesaid to build any part or all of said road, lying within said money. town of Greenbush, be authorized and empowered by major vote, to raise such sum or sums of money, as may be necessary to build and make the road aforesaid, to be expended in labor or money on How expended. said road, as the said inhabitants shall determine; with power to Power to choose choose such agent or agents, or other officers, as said town of Milford may deem necessary and proper, to superintend the laying out of said money within said town of Greenbush, and such person or persons so chosen to superintend the laying out said money, shall possess and exercise all the powers, rights and privileges, which Their powers.
