CHAP. 124.

Chapter 124.

AN ACT additional to an act incorporating the Bangor and Piscataquis Canal and Rail Road Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Exempted from
sect. 6 of an act
relating to rail
roads, passed
March 7, 1842.

The rail road from Bangor to Oldtown, built under the charter of "the Bangor and Piscataquis Canal and Rail Road Company," is hereby exempted from the operation of the sixth section of an act relating to rail roads, passed March seventh, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two.

[Approved March 24, 1843.]

Chapter 125.

AN ACT to make valid the doings of certain school districts in Belfast.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

School district
meetings in Bel-
fast, &c. made
valid.

SECT. 1. In all cases of school district meetings in Belfast, heretofore held, which have been called by any district agent not previously sworn, the doings of such district shall not be deemed void or illegal in consequence thereof.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its approval by the governor.

Chapter 126.

AN ACT to apportion and assess on the inhabitants of this state a tax of two hundred one thousand six hundred and three dollars thirty four cents.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. That each city, town, plantation, or other place hereinafter named, within this state, shall be assessed and pay the several sums with which they respectively stand charged, viz :

SECT. 2. The treasurer of the state shall forthwith send his warrant, directed to the mayor and aldermen, selectmen or assessors of each city, town, plantation, or other place taxed as aforesaid, requiring them respectively to assess the sum so charged, in manner following, viz: on the male polls, above the age of twenty one years, within their respective cities, towns and plantations, one sixth part of the whole sum to be assessed; and if, by the above rule, the proportion of the state, county and city, town or plantation taxes, (exclusive of highway taxes) to be paid by the polls, shall, in any city, town or plantation, exceed two dollars on each poll, it shall be reduced so as to make that sum; and the highway taxes in such city, town or plantation, shall be assessed in the same proportion on each poll; and the residue of such sum, charged as aforesaid to each city, town, plantation or other place respectively, to assess upon the respective inhabitants thereof, according to the value of the real estate therein owned or possessed by each of them on the first day of May next, either in his own right, or the right of others, improved or not improved, (except pews in houses of public worship,) or upon the owners of real estate in such city, town, plantation, or other place, whether such owner resides in the same or not, on said first day of May, according to the just value thereof; and upon the non-resident proprietors of real estates lying within such city, town, plantation or other place, in their own right, or the right of others, improved or not improved; and also on all the inhabitants of such city, town, plantation or place, and all other persons possessing estates within the same, on said first day of May, according to the proportion of the amount of their respective personal estates, including all moneys at interest more than they pay interest for, all debts due to them more than they are indebted for, moneys of all kinds on hand, public securities of all sorts, all bank stock, shares (or property) in any incorporated company for a bridge or a turnpike road, or shares in any other incorporated company, excepting shares in manufacturing and rail road corporations, possessing taxable property, according to the just value thereof, and also the amount of all goods, wares and merchandize, or any stock in trade, including stock employed in manufactories, not exempted by law; vessels of all kinds, whether at home or abroad, with all their stores and appurtenances; and all pleasure carriages drawn by one or more horses; mules, neat cattle and horses, each of one year old and upwards, and swine six months old and upwards; and also the amount of income of such inhabitants from any profession, employment, or by any annuity, or legacy, or from rents for any real or personal property, or other source, or

gained by trading at sea or on land, and all other property of the several kinds returned in the last valuation for the purpose of taxation ; excepting sheep to the number, not exceeding forty, owned by any one person, household furniture, to the value of four hundred dollars, being the property of one family, and musical instruments to the value of fifteen dollars, being also the property of one family, wearing apparel, farming tools, tools of mechanics necessary for carrying on their business.

SECT. 3. Every freeholder or tenant, who, by virtue of this act, may be assessed, and shall pay any sum for real estate in his possession, may require his landlord, the owner or agent of such estate, to reimburse the half of such sum, unless it be otherwise provided for by an agreement between them. All logs, timber or other unmanufactured lumber shall be taxed therefor, in the town where the owner or manufacturer thereof resides, whether the same be in the town where such owner or manufacturer resides, or in any other place, for the purpose of being driven to market or to be manufactured. And all rail roads or rail road property shall be considered and taxed as real estate, according to the true value thereof, in the town where said rail road is located ; also all property, real and personal, belonging to manufacturing corporations, shall be taxed in the town where the same is situate. And every owner of horses, mules, sheep, or neat cattle, shall be taxed therefor, in the city, town, plantation or other place, wherein he may be an inhabitant, on said first day of May, notwithstanding any of said creatures may be in some other place, for any purpose whatever.

SECT. 4. The treasurer, in his warrant, shall require the said mayor and aldermen, selectmen or assessors, respectively, to make a fair list or lists of their assessments, setting forth in distinct columns, against each person's name, how much he or she is assessed for polls, and how much for real estate, and how much for personal estate and income as aforesaid, distinguishing any sum assessed on such person as guardian, or for any estate in his or her possession in trust, and also insert in such list the number of acres of unimproved land, which they may have taxed on each non-resident proprietor of lands, and the value at which they may have estimated the same ; and such list or lists, when completed and signed by them, or the major part of them, to commit to the collector or collectors, constable or constables of such city, town, plantation or other places respectively, with a warrant or warrants, in due form of law, requiring them to collect and pay the same to the treasurer, on or before the first day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four, and also to return a certifi-

cate of the names of such collector or collectors, constable or constables, with the sum total which they may be so required to collect, to the said treasurer, sometime before the first day of December next.

SECT. 5. All goods, wares and merchandize, or other stock in trade, including stock employed in manufactories, logs, timber, boards and other lumber, shall be taxed in the city, town, or plantation, or other place where they are sold, used or improved, notwithstanding the owner or owners may reside in some other place: *Provided*, such person or persons do occupy or improve a shop, store or mill in such city, town, plantation or other place, where the property before named is sold, used or improved; and they shall be respectively held to deliver on oath or affirmation, if required, a list of their whole taxable estates to the assessors of the city, town, plantation or other place where they may dwell, on said first day of May next, distinguishing what part thereof is taxable elsewhere, and in default thereof they may be doomed by said assessors: *Provided, however*, that this clause shall in no case be so construed as to enable the assessors of any city, town, plantation, or other place, to assess an inhabitant of any city, town, plantation, or other place, for any other property than what is contained on the list which may be delivered, as aforesaid.

SECT. 6. All property and estate belonging to any literary or charitable institution shall be exempted from assessment and taxation, and no person shall be taxed in any city, town, plantation, or other place, on account or by reason of his residing there as a student in any literary seminary; but students shall be taxed in the cities, towns, plantations or other places, where they have their established residence; and Indians shall not be assessed and taxed for their polls and estates. And if there be any persons, who, by reason of their poverty, age, or bodily infirmity, may be unable to contribute towards the public charges, in the judgment of said assessors, they may exempt the polls and estates of such persons, or abate any part of the sum which they are assessed at, as the said assessors may think just and equitable. And inhabitants of islands, on which there are no highways, may be omitted in any highway tax, at the discretion of the city, town, plantation or other place to which they belong.

SECT. 7. The county commissioners, in their respective counties, when duly authorized to assess a county tax, shall apportion the same on the several cities, towns, plantations, and other places therein, according to the proportion at which they are rated in this act. And in the assessment of all county, city, town, plantation, parish or society taxes, the assessors of each city, town, plantation,

parish, society or other place, within this State, shall govern themselves by the same rules, and assess the polls therein, in the proportion as they may be assessed to pay a State tax by virtue of this act, having regard to all such alterations of polls and property as may happen within the same, subsequent to the assessment of the tax made by this act, excepting such parishes and societies, for which a different provision for assessing their taxes is made by law : *Provided, always,* that it shall be lawful for any city, town, plantation, parish or society, to make, levy and collect any county, city, town, plantation, parish or society tax, according to a new valuation, and for that purpose to cause a new valuation to be taken therein, at any time of the year which may be determined upon at a legal meeting to be warned for that purpose.

SECT. 8. The assessors shall make their several rate lists, to be committed to the collectors or constables, in such form, in substance, as shall be prescribed by the treasurer of the state, when he transmits his warrants to the several cities, towns, and plantations, as herein directed.

Chapter 127.

AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Appropriations for expenses of government.

Governor to draw his warrants prior to Jan. 1, 1844.

In order to provide for the operation of certain acts and resolves of the legislature, requiring the payment of money from the treasury, and also to provide for the necessary expenditures of the government, for the current year, the following sums are hereby appropriated, to be paid out of any moneys in the treasury ; the same to be in lieu of all other existing appropriations whatever. And the governor, with advice of the council, is hereby authorized, at any time prior to the first day of January next, to draw his warrant upon the treasury for the same.
