Resolve authorizing the treasurer of the county of Franklin to borrow money for the use of said county.

Resolved, That the treasurer of the county of Franklin, is hereby Treasurer of authorized to borrow the sum of fourteen hundred dollars, for the Franklin county purpose of building a county house for the safe keeping of the county records: provided he can obtain the same at a rate of interest not exceeding six per cent.
