## Chapter 198.

Resolve additional for the payment of accounts against the state.

Additional roll  
of accounts No.  
24, \$5,627 27.

*Resolved,* That there be allowed and paid out of any money in the treasury of the state, not otherwise appropriated, to the several towns, plantations and persons mentioned in the additional roll of accounts number twenty four, the sums set against the names of such towns, plantations and persons respectively, amounting in the whole to the sum of five thousand, six hundred and twenty seven dollars and twenty seven cents, in full discharge of the claims and demands to which they severally refer.
