Chapter 199.

Resolve in relation to trespasses committed on the public lands.

Resolved. That so much of a resolve, entitled a "resolve in rela- Portion of a retion to trespasses committed on the public lands," approved Febru-ary fourteenth in the year of our L ord one there is the set of the public lands, "approved Febru-passed Feb 14, ary fourteenth, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred 1842, repeated. and forty two, as prohibits the land agent from compromising, or settling, with trespassers on the public lands, when said trespass shall have been accidental, and not wilful, or intentional, is hereby repealed.

Resolved, That the land agent be allowed to settle with such Land agent may trespassers, as may have trespassed by going beyond the limits of trespass is acci-dental. their permits, in accordance with a practice heretofore adopted by the land agent, of allowing persons cutting timber under permits, to cut timber on the adjoining lands when the timber within the limits of their permits has failed, and the trespass was committed prior to and during the winter of the year one thousand eight hundred and forty two.
