Chapter 320.

Снар. 320.

Resolve additional to a resolve providing for a state valuation.

Resolved, That all vacancies, which may happen, by death, re- State valuation, signation, or other disqualification, at the board of the committee on the new state valuation, appointed to sit during the recess of committee to sit the legislature, shall be filled by said committee, by the choice, by during recess. ballot, of one of the members of this legislature, resident within the county within which said deceased or otherwise disqualified member may have resided. And the said committee are authorized to employ a clerk to keep a journal of their proceedings, at a compensation not exceeding two dollars per day.

Chapter 321.

Resolve for paying the clerks of the committee on state valuation.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid from the treasury of Payment of valuthe state, out of any money not otherwise appropriated, to the several clerks of the committee on state valuation, the sums allowed and certified as due them for travel and attendance, amounting in the whole to the sum of one thousand one hundred and seventyseven dollars.

Chapter 322.

Resolve in favor of Alexander Ryerson.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury, to Alexander In favor of Alex-Ryerson, member of the house of representatives, the sum of one ander Ryerson. dollar and fifty cents, it being for deficiency in his pay for travel, as made up in the pay roll.
