CHAP. 323.**Chapter 323.**

Resolve in favor of Moses Rose.

In favor of Mo-  
ses Rose.

*Resolved*, That there be paid out of the treasury, to Moses Rose, the sum of four dollars, it being for two days attendance as member of this house, not made up in the pay roll.

[*Approved March 22, 1844.*]**Chapter 324.**

Resolve in favor of Smith Libby.

In favor of Smith  
Libby.

*Resolved*, That there be paid out of the treasury, to Smith Libby, the sum of three dollars, being for an error in making up his compensation in the pay roll of the house, for watching the public buildings during the present session of the legislature.
