Chapter 130.

AN ACT altering the times of holding the stated sessions of the county commissioners in the county of Hancock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. From and after the passage of this act the stated Altering the state meetings of the county commissioners, for the county of Hancock, county commissioners in the shall he holden at Ellsworth, in said county, on the second Tues- county of Hancock. day of April, and fourth Tuesday of October, in each year, instead of the times now established by law for such meetings.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts, inconsistent with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed; and this act shall take effect from and after its approval by the governor.

Chapter 131.

AN ACT regulating the compensation to jailors for the support of prisoners in county jails.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:
