Chapter 221.

AN ACT to incorporate the Buxton Woolen Manufacturing Company. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Jeremiah Hobson, Joseph Hobson, Oliver Dow, H. J. Libby, F. Corporatore. O. Libby, Alanson L. Hobson and their associates and successors, are constituted and made a body politic and corporate, by the name of the Buxton Woolen Manufacturing Company, with all the priv- Corporate name. ileges and subject to all the duties and liabilities provided in the laws of this state concerning manufacturing corporations; and Authorized to are authorized to purchase and hold real and personal estate, not real and personal estate. exceeding in value, at any one time, the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars, and the same may improve, lease, sell and convey, as other proprietors of real and personal estate may lawfully do. And said company are authorized to carry on at Moderation Falls, in Articles of man-Buxton and Hollis, the manufacture of cotton and wool and such other materials as may be necessarily or conveniently connected therewith, and may erect and construct such machinery, mills and other buildings as may be useful for that purpose.

Chapter 222.

AN ACT io incorporate the Trustees of the School Funds in East Livermore. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Nathaniel Mayo, Alexander Ford, Amos Hobbs, Aa- Corporators. ron Barton and Francis F.
