Chapter 325.

Resolves providing for a state valuation.

Resolved, That the committee of thirteen, chosen by the legislature of eighteen hundred and forty-four, to make out a state valuation in the recess of the legislature, be authorized and directed to make out and report a state valuation, to this legislature. *Provided*, that the members of that committee, who are now members of the legislature, shall not act on said committee after the twenty-fifth day of January, instant, without a new election. State valuation.

Resolved, That all vacancies which may happen by resignation, or otherwise, at the board of the committee, shall be filled by this legislature. Vacancies.

Chapter 326.

Resolve in favor of John H. Boynton.
