Chapter 340.

CHAP. 340.

Resolve in favor of Joseph L. Kelsey.

Resolved, That Joseph L. Kelsey, is hereby released from the performance of settling duties on lot number one hundred and forty eight, in township number one, Indian purchase, as required in the deed of conveyance by the state, dated the sixteenth of June, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five.

Resolve in favor of Walker Darling.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to convey by deed to Walker Darling, lot numbered one, in the ninth range, in the town of Lowell.

In favor of W. Darling.

[*Approved February 28, 1845.*]**Chapter 342.**

Resolve in favor of the town of Passadumkeag.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to quit claim to the town of Passadumkeag, all the right, title and interest the state has to lots numbered fifty-six, sixty-eight, sixty-nine, and the meadow tract, known as the Danforth lot, in said town, for the purpose of enabling said town to repair the state road and bridges on the same, in said town.

Resolve in favor of Nicholas Pierce.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of state, to Nicholas Pierce, of Limerick, the sum of four dollars and fifty cents per month, during the term of five years, commencing on the tenth day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-four, the same being a pension for an injury sustained by him while on military duty.
