SECT. 5. The said William Moor and Daniel Moor, junior, their associates and assigns, are hereby created a body corporate, by the name of the Penobscot River Navigation Company, with Corporate name, the powers incident to corporations described and defined in the General powers, seventy-sixth chapter of the revised statutes, and at common law, provided, that they shall at any time during the continuance of the Proviso. above grant, elect by the vote of a majority in interest, and proceed to organize under and according to the provisions of said chapter of the revised statutes.

#### Chapter 362.
