CHAP. 380.

Fish committee, how chosen.
 Compensation.
 Penalty for neglect or refusal to choose such committee.
 How recovered.

SECT. 7. It shall be the duty of said town of Orland at their annual meeting in March or April, to choose a fish committee, to consist of one or more persons, who shall be sworn to the faithful discharge of the duties required of them by this act; and each of said committee shall be entitled to receive one dollar per day for his services to be paid by said town; and if said town shall neglect or refuse to choose said committee, they shall forfeit and pay the sum of fifty dollars for every such neglect or refusal, to be recovered by any person who shall sue therefor in an action of debt for his own use and benefit, in any court competent to try the same.

Their duty.
 Penalty for willful neglect.

SECT. 8. It shall be the duty of said fish committee to see that the requirements of this act are complied with and to prosecute in their own names, for the use and benefit of said town, all persons who shall be guilty of violating the same, in an action of debt in any court of competent jurisdiction; and said fish committee shall for any willful neglect of duty, forfeit and pay the sum of fifty dollars, to be recovered by any person who shall sue therefor, in an action of debt, for his own use and benefit.

Inconsistent acts repealed.
 Cha. 61, R. S. not construed so as to effect the operations of this act

SECT. 9. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed; and the provisions of chapter sixty-one of the revised statutes shall not be so construed, as to effect in any way the operation of this act.

Chapter 380.

An Act to apportion and assess a state tax of one hundred thousand, four hundred fifty-one dollars and eighteen cents, for the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

State tax, \$100,451 18.

SECTION 1. Each city, town, plantation or other place, hereinafter named, within this state, shall be assessed and pay the several sums with which they respectively stand charged, as follows:

SECT. 2. The treasurer of state shall, in the month of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, send his warrant with a copy of this act, directed to the mayor and aldermen, selectmen or assessors, of each city, town, or plantation or other place, taxed as aforesaid, requiring them respectively to assess in dollars and cents the sums so charged, according to the provisions of the tax law approved, April fifth, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, and the fourteenth chapter of the revised statutes; and to add the amount of such tax to the amount of county and town taxes, to be by them assessed in each city, town, plantation or other place respectively.

Treasurer to issue his warrant, &c.

SECT. 3. The treasurer in his said warrant, shall require the said mayor and aldermen, selectmen or assessors, respectively, to pay or to issue their several warrant or warrants, requiring the collectors of their several cities, towns and plantations, to pay to the

Said tax to be paid into the treasury on or before January 1, 1848.

CHAP. 381. said treasurer, on or before the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight, the sums against said cities, towns and plantations, respectively in this act contained; and the said selectmen or assessors, respectively, shall return a certificate of the names of such collectors, with the sum which each may be required to collect, to the said treasurer, some time before the first day of December, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven.

SECT. 4. The notice required by section first, chapter fourteenth of the revised statutes, shall be given in the manner therein provided; within three months after the first day of April, eighteen hundred and forty-seven, so far as the same may be necessary under this act, and all the provisions of article first of said chapter fourteen, shall, so far as the tax herein provided for is concerned, have reference to said first day of April accordingly.

Chapter 381.

An additional Act relating to the Kennebec Log Driving Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Authorized to collect and secure logs remaining in booms, or exposed to loss, after 1st of October.

SECTION 1. Whenever the directors of the Kennebec Log Driving Company shall judge it for the interest of the owners of logs and other timber remaining in the booms or in any place exposed to loss, after the first day of October in any year, to collect and deposite in suitable and convenient places and properly secure the same; they are hereby authorized so to collect and deposit such logs and timber thus situated; and to use all reasonable care safely to keep the same, until removed by the owners thereof, or are otherwise disposed of in the manner provided in this act.

Expenses incurred thereon, how assessed and collected.

SECT. 2. Upon all logs and other timber thus collected and deposited, the directors shall assess the expense actually incurred thereon, with such additional sums as may be deemed necessary to cover necessary future expenditures upon them while in their charge; and the method of proceeding for the collection of assessments thus made, shall be the same as provided by law in relation to assessments for driving logs upon Kennebec river; and said company shall have a lien upon the logs and other timber for the full payment of all expenses; or the treasurer may recover such assessments, and all other assessments made by virtue of an act relating to said company approved March third, in the year of our
