Chapter 395.

An Act to incorporate the Readfield Woolen Manufacturing Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Lewis Flanders and Lewis F. Sherborn, their asso- comparators. ciates, successors and assigns, are hereby created a corporation, by the name of the Readfield Woolen Manufacturing Company, for corporate name. the purpose of manufacturing woolen and other goods, in the town facture. of Readfield, in the county of Kennebec; with power by that name of Readfield, in the county of Kennebec; with power by that name Powers, privileges to sue and be sued, and use a common seal, and have all privileges ges and liabilities. and powers, and be subject to all the duties, liabilities and requirements granted or required by the laws of the state relating to manufacturing corporations.

The said corporation may purchase and hold real and Authorized to Sect. 2. personal estate to an amount not exceeding, at any one time, fifty hold and control real and personal thousand dollars, with full power to manage and dispose of the same.

Either of the persons named in this act, may call the First meeting, first meeting of said corporation, at such time and place as he may see fit, by giving notice of the same in writing, delivered to the other, seven days before said meeting, for the purpose of organizing said corporation.

This act shall take effect from and after its approval by the governor.
