Chapter 459.

Resolve authorizing the abatement of certain taxes upon township letter D, in Franklin county.

Resolved, That the treasurer of state be directed to abate so Abatement of much of the taxes heretofore assessed on township letter D, in taxes on Letter D, Franklin co. Franklin county, as remained unpaid on the fifth day of December last, amounting to forty dollars and four cents.

Chapter 460.

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Resolve in favor of Samuel Chesley.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to surrender In favor of Sam'l to Samuel Chesley a note of hand given by said Chesley to the state bearing date June second, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, for eighty-one dollars and five cents, and payable in four years from the date of said note.

Chapter 461.

Resolves in relation to the binding of the acts and resolves of this state.

Resolved, That the special or private acts and the resolves passed Binding acts and since eighteen hundred and forty-one, shall constitute the fifth volume of each, and that the public acts passed since eighteen hundred and thirty nine, shall also constitute a volume.

Resolved, That the secretary of state cause a title page, table of contents and general index, to be prepared for each volume; and that he cause thirty sets of said acts and resolves to be substantially bound and properly lettered for the use of the executive and legislative departments of the government.

Resolved, That a sum not exceeding one hundred and fifty dol-

Chapter 462.

Resolve in favor of Ira Fish.

Resolved, That a further time of three years be granted to Ira Fish for performing the settling duties required by law on the following described land purchased of the state, viz; section number twelve, and lot letter B, in township number eight, range five, west from the east line of the state; section number six, section number thirty-six, lot number eleven, lot number twenty-six, the southwest quarter of section number twenty-nine, and Sugar Island, in township number nine, range six west from the east line of the state; section number thirty-six and lot number fifty-four in township number eleven, range five west from the east line of the state; section number eleven, in township number eleven, tange six west from the east line of the state; *provided* said Fish shall pay all sums due the state for the above described lands on or before the first day of January next.

Chapter 463.

Resolve providing for the repair of the Military road.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to expend a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars in repairing the Military road, to be laid out at any time before July, eighteen hundred and forty-seven.
