### Chapter 462.

Resolve in favor of Ira Fish.

In favor of Ira Fish.

*Resolved*, That a further time of three years be granted to Ira Fish for performing the settling duties required by law on the following described land purchased of the state, viz ; section number twelve, and lot letter B, in township number eight, range five, west from the east line of the state ; section number six, section number thirty-six, lot number eleven, lot number twenty-six, the southwest quarter of section number twenty-nine, and Sugar Island, in township number nine, range six west from the east line of the state ; section number thirty-six and lot number fifty-four in township number eleven, range five west from the east line of the state ; section number eleven, in township number eleven, range six west from the east line of the state ; *provided* said Fish shall pay all sums due the state for the above described lands on or before the first day of January next.

### Chapter 463.

Resolve providing for the repair of the Military road.

*Resolved*, That the land agent is hereby authorized to expend a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars in repairing the Military road, to be laid out at any time before July, eighteen hundred and forty-seven.
