Chapter 507.

Resolve for the pay roll of the house of representatives.

Pay roll of the house of representatives. Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of this state to the several persons named in the foregoing pay roll, the sums set against their names respectively amounting in the whole to thirty thousand three hundred and forty-six dollars.
